OPINION AND ORDER

Matich Tank Lines, Inc., has changed its corporate name to Poulsen Tank Lines, Inc. It requests that operative authority heretofore granted to Matich Tank Lines, Inc., authorizing service as a petroleum irregular route carrier be amended accordingly.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED:


1. That Decision No. 55530, dated September 10, 1957, in Application No. 39367 and Decision No. 56744, dated May 27, 1958, in Application No. 40006, are hereby amended by substituting "Poulsen Tank Lines, Inc.," in place of "Matich Tank Lines, Inc."

2. That within ninety days after the effective date hereof, and on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and to the public, applicant shall supplement or reissue the tariffs on file with the Commission naming rates, rules and regulations governing the common carrier operations here involved to show that Matich Tank Lines, Inc., has withdrawn or canceled and Poulsen Tank Lines, Inc., has adopted or established as its own, said rates, rules and regulations. The tariff filings made pursuant to this order shall comply


in all respects with the regulations governing the construction and filing of tariffs set forth in the Commission's General Order No. 80.


The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.




