<u>ORDER</u>

The City of Coronado is suthorized to construct an alley, located between "B" Avenue and "C" Avenue, at grade across San Diego and Arizona Eastern Railway Company's Coronado Branch in the City of Coronado, San Diego County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. 36C-20.59-D. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. San Diego and Arizona Eastern Railway Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be substantially as shown on the plan attached to the application with grades of approach not greater than two percent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by one Standard No. 1 crossing sign, General Order No. 75-B, with reflex reflecting sheet material.

The above is conditioned upon the extension of the proposed asphalt concrete pavement south of the track a minimum distance of one hundred feet beyond that shown upon the print attached to the application. Further, applicant shall take

appropriate steps to officially designate said alley as restricted to one-way traffic southbound only, and a copy of the local ordinance or other mandate shall be filed with the Commission prior to commencement of construction.

Within thirty days after completion, pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with, including the retention of the one-way traffic provision. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
