## OPINION AND ORDER

Donner Lake Utility Company, <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> a corporation, by its application filed on August 22, 1960, requests an order of the Commission approving an executed right-of-way contract dated May 18, 1960 between Donner and the Division of Highways, Department of Public Works, State of California <sup>2</sup>/<sub>2</sub> which provides for the conveyance of public utility property to State in accordance with the provisions thereof. An executed copy of the contract entitled "Right of Way Contract -State Highway" is attached to the application and made a part thereof. The property is described in that contract as:

> "All that portion of Section 7, T. 17 N., R. 16 E., and Section 14 T. 17 N., R. 15 E., M.D.B.& M., as more particularly described in Document No. 12976-1,2."

The application itself states, in addition, that the land to be transferred to the State consists of three parcels totalling 10.05 acres, which includes 0.95 acres of access road.

By letter dated September 14, 1960, applicant submitted maps indicating the areas being transferred and alleged that the

relocation of utility facilities necessitated by the new freeway could be effected without interruption of service to the utility's customers. This letter, with accompanying maps, is hereby received in evidence as Exhibit No. 1.

The action taken herein shall not be construed to be a finding of the value of the properties herein authorized to be transferred.

The Commission has considered the above-entitled application and is of the opinion, and so finds, that the transfer, in accordance with the terms of the contract, will not be adverse to the public interest and that a public hearing is not necessary; therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

A. 42588 d

1. On or after the effective date hereof and on or before November 1, 1961, Donner Lake Utility Company may transfer, in accordance with the terms of the contract dated May 18, 1960 between itself and State, the portions of its public utility water system properties referred to therein.

2. Within thirty days thereafter Donner Lake Utility Company shall:

- (a) Notify the Commission in writing of the completion of the property transfer herein authorized.
- (b) Furnish to this Commission a copy of the journal entries used to record this sale and the other transactions called for by the contract on its books of account which

entries shall be in accordance with the Uniform System of Accounts for Class D Water Utilities prescribed by this Commission.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
