ORDER DENYING REHEARING

The applicant, Newport Bay Investment Company, has filed a petition for rehearing with respect to Decision No. 60662 entered on August 30, 1960, in the above-entitled proceeding, alleging, among other things, that the Commission failed to make findings with respect to the need for service to points on Catalina Island other than Avalon. On September 6, 1960, in Decision No. 60706 in Application No. 42109, the Commission granted to the Island Transportation Company authority to render charter service to all points on Catalina Island. We do not believe there is a need that such service be rendered by two different operators. In our opinion no good cause for rehearing has been made to appear.

IT IS ORDERED that said petition for rehearing be and it is hereby denied.
