## BEFORE THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

In the Matter of the Application of the COUNTY OF CONTRA COSTA, State of California, for a crossing at the grade of the tracks of the Southern Pacific Company at the Burton-Alamo Freeway, near Alamo, California.

## <u>ORDER</u>

It appearing that a public hearing is unnecessary and that there is good cause therefor,

IT IS ORDERED that the County of Contra Costa is authorized to construct Burton-Alamo Road at grade across the tracks of Southern Pacific Company, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. EO-51.9. Applicant County shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Southern Pacific Company, which has consented to this crossing, shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. The width of the crossing shall be not less than forty feet and grades of approach not greater than one percent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 (General Order No. 72). Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (General Order No. 75-B) reflectorized with reflex-reflecting sheet material.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that prior to the completion of Crossing No. BO-51.9 the grade crossing at Jones Road, located approximately 500 feet distant, shall be abolished by physical closing. Within thirty days after completion, pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year after the

effective date of this order unless time be extended, and if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
