O R D E R

State of California, Department of Public Works, is authorized to construct State Route 158 (San Diego Freeway) at separated grades over Pacific Electric Railway Company's Gardena-San Pedro Line, at the location described and in the manner as shown in the application to be identified as Crossing No. 6RC-15.46-A.

Construction and maintenance expense shall be borne in accordance with an agreement to be entered into between the parties, and a copy of said executed agreement, together with plans of said structure approved by the railway, shall be filed with the Commission prior to commencement of construction. Should the parties fail to agree, the Commission will apportion the cost of construction and maintenance by further order.

Clearances shall be in conformance with the provisions of General Order No. 26-D except that during the period of construction, applicant is authorized to create impaired clearances of 20 feet vertically above top of rail and 2 feet 6 inches horizontally from

center line of track and Pacific Electric Railway Company is authorized to operate with such temporary impaired clearance conditions, provided it issue appropriate bulletins to train and engine crews advising them of the impaired clearance conditions and forbidding trainmen to ride on the tops and sides of cars while operating beneath the structure.

Within thirty days after completion of the structure, pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within two years, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
