ORDER

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct a spur track at grade in 18th Street across Shotwell Street in the City and County of San Francisco, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. E-2.43-C. Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding one percent. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs reflectorized with reflex-reflecting sheet material. (General Order No. 75-B) Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.


Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.


Applicant proposes to construct said spur track simultaneously with extensive street reconstruction now scheduled to be performed by the City and County of San Francisco within the immediate future. In order to avoid expensive delay, applicant


asks that the authorization be made effective immediately.


The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.


