FINAL ORDER

By these applications, United Air Lines, Inc., Western Air Lines, Inc., and Trans World Airlines, Inc., respectively sought increases in passenger fares of 17 percent, 6 percent plus \$2 per one-way ticket, and 15 percent. By Decision No. 56849, dated June 17, 1958, in these proceedings, applicants, together with other air lines, were authorized to establish increases of four percent plus one dollar per one-way adult fare. The instant applications were kept open and hearings were continued to a date to be set to receive further evidence concerning the full amounts of the increases sought.

On June 29, 1960 Western Air Lines, Inc., filed Application No. 42417, seeking an increase in passenger fares of 2½ percent plus \$1 per one-way fare. On July 1, 1960 Trans World Airlines, Inc., filed Application No. 42430 and on July 14, 1960 United Air

Lines, Inc., filed Application No. 42461, both of which seek similar increases. Public hearings have been held in said applications and the matters have been taken under submission.

Under the circumstances the instant applications are moot; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that Decision No. 56849, dated June 17, 1958, as supplemented by Decision No. 56924, dated July 1, 1958, is made final in these applications and that further proceedings are discontinued.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
