FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Applicants were granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity to construct and operate a public utility water system in Tract No. 6 Southwood Park Subdivision, Sonoma County by Decision No. 60262, dated June 14, 1960, herein. However, the certificate granted was not authorized to become effective until the utility provided, in a manner acceptable to the Commission, for the reasonable continuation of an adequate supply of water in case of failure of its present single well source.

A letter received from the utility on October 19, 1960, states that a second well capable of producing 85 gallons of water per minute with presently utilized pumping facilities has been added to the system. This alternate supply, while not sufficient to satisfy the requirements of this Commission's General Order No. 103 as an independent source, appears to be adequate to provide standby service and the Commission so finds; therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the condition imposed by paragraph 1 of Decision No. 60262, supra, has been met by applicants, compliance therewith being deemed to have been effected on the date hereof.

In all other respects Decision No. 60262 shall remain in full force and effect.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
