OPINION

By this petition the California Dump Truck Owners Association, Inc., seeks increases and other changes in certain rates that have heretofore been prescribed as minimum rates for for-hire

carriers engaged in the transportation of designated materials by dump truck equipment between points in Southern California. The rates which are involved are the zone rates that are set forth in Minimum Rate Tariff No. 7 for the transportation of sand, gravel, stone, decomposed granite, asphaltic concrete and cold road oil mixture within the portions of Los Angeles, Kern and San Bernardino Counties that lie generally within the area known as the Antelope Valley. Said rates were established in February, 1958. Petitioner alleges that since that time the carriers' costs of operation have increased, and that compensating adjustments should be made in the rates to restore them to a reasonable level. Petitioner also alleges that experience under the rates has demonstrated a need for certain other changes in the tariff provisions related thereto.

Specifically, petitioner seeks (a) an increase of 20 percent in the rates which apply for the transportation of asphaltic concrete and cold road oil mixture; (b) the cancellation of rates for sand, gravel, stone and decomposed granite which are subject to a minimum weight of 18 tons; (c) various revisions in the zones, and (d) certain changes in the form of the applicable tariff provisions. Assertedly, such increases and related changes are necessary to bring the zone rates into closer alignment with present conditions.

The cancellation of the 18-ton rates for sand, gravel, stone and decomposed granite would result in increases in charges for the transportation of shipments of those materials in quantities of 18 tons or more. With the cancellation of the 18-ton rates, rates which are subject to a minimum of 8 tons would become applicable. The 8-ton rates are about 25 to 30 percent higher than the 18-ton rates.

In a sense the matters which are covered by this petition are the same, in part, as those which are covered in another petition, Petition No. 48, which the California Dump Truck Owners Association, Inc., has filed seeking revisions in the zone rates in Minimum Rate Tariff No. 7 for the transportation of rock, sand, gravel and decomposed granite in Southern California. It appears, however, that the proposals in the instant petition are intended to obviate the necessity for further work under Petition No. 48 in connection with the zone rates for the Antelope Valley area.

Public hearing on the above proposals was held before Examiner C. S. Abernathy at Lancaster on June 22, 1960, and at Los Angeles on June 23, 1960. Evidence was presented by petitioner's manager, by several dump truck carriers, and by two producers of rock products. A representative of the California Trucking Associations, Inc., and members of the Commission's staff participated in the development of the record.

By the proposed increases of 20 percent in the rates for asphaltic concrete and cold road oil mixture, petitioner seeks to overcome asserted deficiencies in the rates when established, and to meet operating losses which the carriers allegedly are now experiencing. According to testimony of petitioner's

Revision of the zone rates in Southern California is also a matter that is pending in another phase of this general proceeding. By Order Setting Hearing, dated March 24, 1959, the Commission has directed its staff to investigate the costs, rates, rules, zones and other matters pertaining to the transportation of property by dump truck within California to the end of developing recommendations for specific tariff changes.

manager and of several carrier witnesses, it became evident soon after the present rates were established in 1958 that they were insufficient. As a consequence the carriers and shippers agreed that the rates that would be assessed and paid for the transportation of asphaltic concrete and cold road oil mixture would be 15 percent above the prescribed rates. Despite this adjustment in rates, however, the carriers have not been able to maintain their operations on a profitable level. During the past two years the volume of the carriers' traffic has declined and their expenses have increased. Petitioner's manager submitted figures to show that during 1959 the carriers' operating expenses (including allowance for compensation for the owner-operators) exceeded their revenues by about 5 percent. This amount is the approximate equivalent of the increase that petitioner seeks in the carriers' effective or "going" rates. Thus, the figures of petitioner's manager would indicate that establishment of the sought increases would serve only to enable the carriers to meet their present level of expenses, and would provide but little, if any, allowance for profit.

Petitioner's proposals with respect to cancellation of the rates for sand, gravel, stone and decomposed granite that are subject to a minimum weight of 18 tons have as a principal objective a greater participation of the for-hire carriers in the Antelope Valley area in the transportation of those materials.

Since the carriers' present or "going" rates are now 15 percent above the zone rates in Minimum Rate Tariff No. 7, it is evident that establishment of the sought increases of 20 percent in the minimum rates would result in an increase of but 5 percent in the carriers' effective or "going" rates.

At the present time, the record shows, the transportation of those materials is performed largely by the producers of said materials by means of proprietary equipment. Carrier witnesses who testified in support of this proposal stated that the maintenance of the 18-ton scale of rates in conjunction with the higher scale based on a minimum weight of 8 tons operates to exclude the forhire carriers from engaging in the transportation of the rock products named. They explained that with the two scales of rates in effect the sales of rock products are made on the basis that the transportation of said products will be at the lower rates. They said, however, that virtually all of the carriers which are domiciled in the Antelope Valley area do not operate equipment of sufficient capacity to transport 18 tons at one time, and that the rates are much too low to be compensatory for the transportation of such quantities in multiple loads. They said that as a consequence the carriers are not able to enter into the transportation of the aforesaid rock products. Instead, the transportation is performed by the rock products producers by means of their own equipment. The carrier witnesses expressed the view that cancellation of the 18-ton scale of rates (leaving the higher, 8-ton rates to become the governing rates) would provide a basis upon which the carriers could perform the transportation involved.

Petitioner's proposals in this respect were supported by witnesses for two rock products producers who would be affected thereby. The testimony of these witnesses was much the same as that of the carrier witnesses with respect to the delivery of rock products. The witnesses said that virtually all of the rock products deliveries of the producers which they represent are made by the producers' own transportation facilities; that the producers would employ for-hire carriers for this purpose also, but that under the present rate structure for the transportation of rock products, the services of the for-hire carriers cannot be obtained. They favored the cancellation of the 18-ton rates as a measure which would enable said producers to employ for-hire carriers when needed, and which would thereby give greater flexibility to the producers' operations. The witnesses said that the other Antelope Valley rock products producers also are not opposed to cancellation of the 18-ton rates.

The revisions in zones which petitioner seeks would result in the establishment of new zones in some instances and the cancellation of present zones in other instances. In general, many of the present zones would be reduced in size, and new zones would be created as a consequence. Some of the zones would be revised to reflect changes in highway locations which have occurred since the present zones were established. According to petitioner's manager, the proposed zone changes are revisions which experience under the present zone rates shows should be made to meet the needs of the carriers and of the shippers.

In addition to proposing revisions in the present zone boundaries, petitioner also recommended that a new numbering system for the zones be adapted. As explained by petitioner's manager, the principal purpose of this recommendation is the renumbering of the zones to conform with a plan which is being developed to bring about the establishment of a coordinated numbering system for all dump truck zones throughout the State. A further purpose, he said, is the establishment of a numbering system which may be readily adapted to present electronic methods of record keeping.

With the foregoing zone proposals, petitioner's manager submitted traverse data to be used in the calculation of zone rates conforming to the revised zones and to the bases of rates herein These data, for the most part, were developed from traverse information already of record in this general proceeding, upon which the present rates were constructed. In other respects the data were developed from time studies which petitioner's manager had made specifically for that purpose.

In connection with the receipt of the aforesaid traverse data, a representative of the California Trucking Associations, Inc., asked that the data be received subject to verification and correction by the Commission's staff. This request was made as a consequence of testimony of petitioner's manager concerning certain difficulties which he had experienced in the development of the data. Petitioner's manager expressed his willingness, on petitioner's behalf, to accept any corrections in the traverse data that the staff's review thereof indicates should be made.

Discussion, Findings and Conclusions

The zone rates which are in issue in this matter were prescribed as an initial step towards the stabilization of transportation conditions applying to dump truck services of for-hire carriers in the Antelope Valley area. In the circumstances which prevailed when the rates were established, the development of

reliable cost figures and related rate factors as bases for the rates was not then possible. Despite the somewhat inadequate record at the time, the zone rates were established in order to provide a medium in which the carriers and shippers might work together more effectively than they could under the minimum rates that otherwise applied. The decision that established the zone rates, Decision No. 56044, describes them as experimental in nature, and it states that, "As experience (under the rates) warrants, the ... rates may be subsequently modified or adjusted as necessary to meet specific operating conditions ..."

It is clear from the record which has been adduced on this instant petition that the rates which Decision No. 56044 established have not fully met expectations. It appears that the dual bases of rates for rock, sand and gravel have not been workable insofar as the Antelope Valley dump truck carriers are concerned. In view of the showing which was made that with but one exception, the carriers are not able to transport loads of 18 tons or more at one time; that the rates which were developed on the basis of an 18 ton minimum are not compensatory for carriers' equipment of lesser capacities, and that in the circumstances the rock products producers favor the cancellation of the 18-ton rates, it is found and concluded that the cancellation of said rates, and such increases in rates and charges as may result from the cancellation of said rates, have been shown to be justified.

It is also found and concluded that the sought increases in the rates for asphaltic concrete and cold road oil mixture have been shown to be justified by the carriers' need for additional

revenues to sustain their services. Consideration being given to the relationship of proposed rates to the carriers' "going" rates and to the carriers' earnings thereunder, it appears that establishment of the sought increases would not result in rates exceeding a reasonable minimum level.

The revisions in zones which petitioner seeks constitute, in effect, a refinement of the present zone basis of rates for the purpose of providing rates more nearly proportionate to the time required in the respective deliveries. These and related proposals appear justified and should be adopted.

The verification of the traverse data which the California Trucking Associations, Inc., requested be made by the Commission's staff is a matter which will be given attention in connection with the state-wide dump truck study now underway.

Upon consideration of the facts and circumstances of record, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the rates, rules and regulations which are prescribed by the order that follows for the transportation of property by for-hire carriers are, and will be, just, reasonable and nondiscriminatory minimum rates for the transportation that would be subject thereto.

ORDER

Based on the evidence of record and on the findings and conclusions in the preceding opinion,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Minimum Rate Tariff No. 7

(Appendix "A" of Decision No. 32566, as amended) be and it is hereby further amended by incorporating therein, to become effective December 31, 1960, the revised pages attached hereto and

listed in Appendix "A", also attached hereto, which pages and appendix are made a part hereof by this reference.

In all other respects, said Decision No. 32566, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the request of the California Trucking Associations, Inc., for certain verification of traverse data which were submitted in this matter be, and it hereby is, denied.

This order shall become effective twenty days after the date hereof.
