OPINION

By the complaint herein filed August 22, 1960, Ralph Herzman complains that defendant incorrectly listed his name and phone number in the Western Section of defendant's 1959 Los Angeles Extended Area telephone directory as therein set forth and requests that defendant be required to permit complainant to inspect the printer's proof of the Western Section of defendant's 1961 Los Angeles Extended Area telephone directory prior to final printing thereof and that defendant be required to take all necessary steps to provide that complainant's telephone listing appear correctly in the Western Section of defendant's 1961 Los Angeles Extended Area telephone directory.

The defendant, General Telephone Company of California, a corporation, filed its answer herein on September 19, 1960, and admitted the allegations of paragraph five of the complaint, and alleged that defendant desires to comply with complainant's wishes as to his listing in the 1961 telephone directory. Defendant's

answer also proposes to make available to complainant as requested the page proof of defendant's 1961 directory on which complainant's listing will appear.

After full consideration of the record consisting of the complaint and the answer, the Commission finds and concludes that the answer of defendant fully satisfies all of the complainant's requests in regard to his telephone listing in the defendant's Western Section of the Los Angeles Extended Area telephone directory.

ORDER

The Commission having considered the above-entitled matter and being of the opinion that a public hearing is not necessary, therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that complainant's request for a corrected listing in the Western Section of defendant's 1961 Los Angeles Extended Area telephone directory and for prior inspection of the page proof thereof is granted and defendant is directed to secure the correct listing for that purpose.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
