## ORDER

The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company is authorized to construct a spur track at grade across Santa Fe Avenue in the City of Escondido, San Diego County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. 2E-20.29-C.

Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72, without superelevation and not less than 24 feet in width, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding one percent. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (General Order No. 75-B), with reflex reflecting sheet material.

Within thirty days after completion, pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

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Applicant has advised the Commission that the industry to be served is in most urgent need of rail service due to unavoidable previous delays in handling and requests waiver of the twentyday waiting period.

The effective date of this order shall therefore be the date hereof.
