OPINION AND ORDER

Paxton Trucking Company, a corporation, operates as a highway common carrier for the transportation of certain specified commodities generally statewide between points in California. In connection with its certificate of public convenience and necessity applicant provides a specialized service of transporting heavy machinery and other commodities of abnormal size and weight which, because of such size and weight, require the use of and are transported on low-bed trailers.

By this application, filed October 10, 1960, authority is sought to increase, by from 1 to 13 percent, certain rates and charges in connection with the above service and to make such increases and related adjustments effective on less than statutory notice.¹

As justification for the proposed increases, the application states that since the most recent adjustments were made in the rates in question, increases have taken place both in the pay scales of labor involved and in other operating costs. Attached to the application are two exhibits showing the development of the increases in such costs. The level of the proposed rates is essentially the same as the developed costs.

Applicant avers that the proposed rates and charges

are substantially on the same level as those currently being assessed by competitive noncertificated low-bed carriers whose operations are exempt from the minimum rate orders of this Commission. Applicant states that shippers are at the present time paying to permitted carriers charges that are no lower, and in most cases higher, than those presented in this application.

The application shows that a copy thereof was served on all known interested parties. No objection to its being granted has been received.

In view of the circumstances, it appears, and the Commission finds, that the proposed increases are justified. A public hearing is not necessary. The application will be granted.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

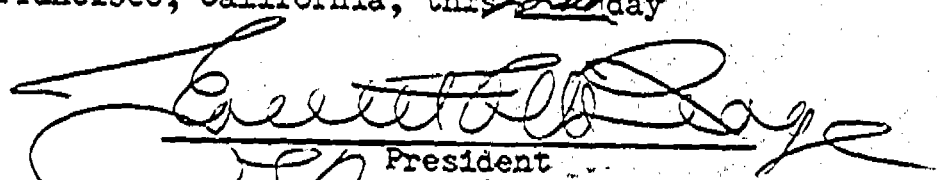
IT IS ORDERED:

(1) That Paxton Trucking Company is hereby authorized to establish, on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and to the public, the proposed rates, rules and regulations set forth in Appendix "A" attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.


(2) That the authority herein granted shall expire unless exercised within ninety days after the effective date hereof.

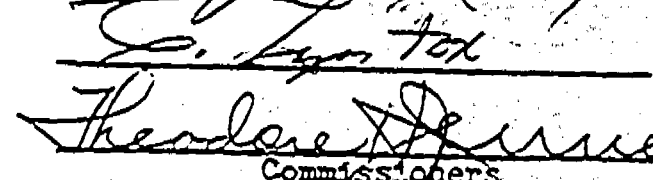
This order shall become effective twenty days after the date hereof.
