ORDER

San Diego & Arizona Eastern Railway Company is authorized to construct a spur track at grade across Alvarado Avenue in the City of La Mesa, San Diego County, at the location as described and in the manner shown in the application.

Applicant shall bear the entire construction and maintenance expense.

Alvarado Avenue is not improved at the point of construction and this authority shall not be construed as authorizing the opening of said street across the track.

Within thirty days after completion, pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require.

Applicant declares that industry to be served will require rail service by December 15, 1960, and requests waiver of the usual twenty-day waiting period.

The effective date of this order shall, therefore, be the date hereof.
