O P I N I O N

This matter relates to the minimum rates, rules and regulations which the Commission has promulgated in Minimum Rate Tariff No. 7 for the transportation of rock, sand, gravel and certain other commodities in dump truck equipment between points in Los Angeles and Orange Counties. The California Dump Truck Owners Association, Inc., petitioner herein, seeks the extension of the zone and area-to-point rates in the tariff to apply from recently-constructed facilities for the production of sand which are located along the Santa Ana River in the approximate vicinity of the community of Yorba Linda and of the City of Orange. Petitioner also seeks the

prescription of additional zone rates from an established production area in Orange County -- Production Area "G."

Public hearing on the petition was held before Examiner C. S. Abernathy at Los Angeles on July 22, 1960.

Evidence was presented by petitioner's manager, by representatives of two rock products producers, and by a carrier of rock products. Representatives of the California Trucking Associations, Inc., and of the Commission's staff participated in the development of the record.

The evidence which was submitted in this matter is substantially to the effect that large quantities of rock products are shipped from the above indicated areas of production to points of destination in Los Angeles and Orange Counties, and that the rates which apply to these movements under present tariff provisions tend to inhibit the utilization of for-hire carriers for said transportation because the rates either are not adapted to the procedures which are followed in the marketing of rock products or they are higher than the rates which apply for similar transportation services in the same general area. Petitioner seeks to overcome these impediments to the use of for-hire facilities for the transportation involved by the establishment of rates corresponding to those which apply for corresponding transportation of rock products from other producing areas in Los Angeles and Orange Counties.<sup>1</sup>

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<sup>1</sup> The term "Los Angeles County" is used herein to mean that portion of the County lying generally between the San Gabriel Mountains and the Pacific Ocean.

Detailed discussion of the evidence is not necessary. It appears that the granting of the petition would do no more than provide rates for the transportation in issue which correspond to the rates which have been prescribed heretofore as reasonable for transportation of the same kind and character from other points of production of rock products in Los Angeles and Orange Counties.

In the circumstances it appears, and the Commission so finds, that the sought revisions in Minimum Rate Tariff No. 7 will result in just, reasonable and nondiscriminatory minimum rates for the transportation that would be subject thereto. The petition will be granted.

O R D E R


Based on the evidence of record and on the findings and conclusions in the preceding opinion,

In all other respects said Decision No. 32566, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.


This order shall become effective twenty days after the date hereof.
