## ORDER

San Bernardino County is authorized to widen the crossing of Cedar Avenue at grade with Southern Pacific Company's El Paso Route (Crossing No. B-534.7) near the community of Bloomington, San Bernardino County, as described and in the manner as shown in the application. Width of crossing shall be not less than 64 feet and grades of approach not greater than two percent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by four Standard No. 8 flashing light signals (General Order No. 75-B).

Construction and maintenance costs shall be borne in accordance with the terms of an agreement entered into between the parties dated May 26, 1960. Maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails shall be borne by applicant. Southern Pacific Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines.

Within thirty days after completion, pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This

authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
