ORDER OF DISMISSAL

Charles C. Canlas, doing business as Peninsula Delivery and Transport Co. was exempted from the requirements of Minimum Rate Tariff No. 2 by Decision No. 57363 dated September 23, 1958 in the transportation of drug supplies, auto parts, bakery supplies, photographic films and prints, and radio and electronic parts and equipment in shipments of 100 pounds or less between points within a 30 mile radius of the City of San Mateo. He was under the misapprehension that said authority is scheduled to expire and therefore filed a petition seeking the renewal thereof. The authority granted by said Decision No. 57363 does not have an expiration date, therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that Petition for Modification No. 203 is dismissed.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
