SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Whereas applicant Boulevard Transportation Company presently holds operative rights as a highway common carrier of General Commodities, without exception, between Los Angeles, Los Angeles Harbor and Long Beach Harbor, and

Whereas Decision No. 60988, dated November 1, 1960 in the above application, when granting extended rights inadvertently placed restrictions upon this operation not intended and not justified by the evidence of record, and the Commission being of the opinion and finding that applicant should not be so restricted,

Now, Therefore, IT IS ORDERED that said restrictions are removed by substituting ^{First} Revised Page 3 of Appendix A to said Decision No. 60988 for Original Page 3 and by deleting therefrom said Original Page 3.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.

5. Liquids, compressed gases, commodities in semi-plastic form and commodities in suspension in liquids in bulk, in tank trucks, tank trailers, tank semitrailers or a combination of such highway vehicles.
6. Commodities when transported in bulk in dump trucks or in hopper-type trucks.
7. Commodities when transported in motor vehicles equipped for mechanical mixing in transit.
8. Logs.

PROVIDED, however, that the above restrictions against transporting general commodities numbered 1 to 8 inclusive shall not apply to movements of general commodities between the points of Los Angeles, Los Angeles Harbor or Long Beach Harbor.
