SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

By Decision No. 59295, dated November 24, 1959, in this proceeding, the Commission established certain minimum rates on fruit juices from Fresno to the San Francisco Bay area and Sacramento. Said rates were established as interim rates pending disposition of another phase of Case No. 5432 in which adjustments of the canned goods rates are at issue,¹ and were therefore published to expire December 31, 1960.

It now appears that the adjustment of the canned goods rates may not be effected prior to December 31, 1960. To avoid a possible lapse of the interim rates on fruit juices, their expiration date will be deferred.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED:

(1) That Minimum Rate Tariff No. 2 (Appendix "D" of Decision No. 31606, as amended) is hereby further amended by incorporating therein, to become effective December 31, 1960, Twelfth Revised Page 46, which revised page is attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.



(2) That tariff publications authorized to be made by common carriers as a result of the order herein may be filed not earlier than the effective date hereof and may be made effective on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and to the public if filed not later than sixty days after the effective date of the minimum rate tariff page incorporated in this order.


(3) That in all other respects said Decision No. 31606, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.


This order shall become effective ten days after the date hereof.
