ORDER VACATING SUSPENSION OF OPERATIVE RIGHTS

Decision No. 61001, dated November 1, 1960, in this proceeding, provided for the suspension of the certificate of public convenience and necessity of Vincent M. McLeod, doing business as Budway Express, unless prior to the effective date of that decision he shall have filed with this Commission a proper and lawful freight classification as required by Sections 486 and 493 of the Public Utilities Code, in which event the order would be stayed.

On October 31, 1960, the Western Classification Committee, Agent, filed the required classification adding Vincent M. McLeod as a participant therein, effective December 15, 1960, thereby staying the Commission's order. Inasmuch as the required classification is now on file, Decision No. 61001, supra, will be vacated.
