ORDER SUSPENDING OPERATIVE RIGHTS

The certificate of insurance of Bernard Witt, doing busi-  
ness as Royal Transportation Co., lapsed as of November 1, 1960.  
Evidence of liability protection required by General Order No. 100A  
not being on file, and the Commission being of the opinion and find-  
ing that such failure constitutes good cause for suspension of cer-  
tificates and of tariffs applicable to services thereunder,

IT IS ORDERED:

(1) That the certificate of public convenience and neces-  
sity to operate as a highway common carrier granted to Bernard Witt,  
doing business as Royal Transportation Co., by Decision No. 60123  
dated May 17, 1960, in Application No. 41888, and acquired by Royal





Transportation Co., Inc., a corporation, by Decision No. 60881, dated October 18, 1960, in Application No. 42663, is hereby suspended pending further order.

(2) That all tariffs issued by or on behalf of Bernard Witt, doing business as Royal Transportation Co., and/or Royal Transportation Co., Inc., are hereby suspended pending further order. A copy of this order shall be filed with said tariffs in the office of the Commission.

The Secretary is directed to cause service of a certified copy of this order to be made upon Bernard Witt and/or Royal Transportation Co., Inc.

The effective date of this order shall be the fifth day after such service, unless before such effective date Bernard Witt or Royal Transportation Co., Inc., shall have been filed with this Commission evidence of insurance protection as required by General Order No. 100A, in which event the effective date of this order shall be stayed until further order of the Commission.
