O P I N I O N

Den Dulk Warehouse & Feed Company, Inc., requests authority to discontinue public warehouse service in Ripon, California.

Applicant possesses a prescriptive right to operate as a public utility warehouseman in 5,000 square feet of floor space. It is alleged that during the year ending April 30, 1960, applicant received a total of \$254.46 in storage revenues; that on June 1, 1960, applicant's capital stock was acquired by the Hayward Poultry Producers Association; that at the present time there is no public storage being conducted on the premises and that there are ample public warehouse facilities in the area.

After consideration, the Commission finds and concludes that public convenience and necessity no longer require applicant's public warehouse service. A public hearing does not appear to be necessary.

O R D E R

Application having been filed and the Commission being informed in the premises,

IT IS ORDERED:

- i. That after the effective date hereof, Den Dulk Warehouse & Feed Company, Inc., may discontinue operations as a public warehouseman in 5,000 square feet of space located in Ripon.

2. That, on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and to the public, applicant shall cancel its tariffs on file with the Commission.

3. That the prescriptive right as a public utility warehouseman at Ripon possessed by Den Dulk Warehouse & Feed Company, Inc., as determined in Case No. 6881 dated August 23, 1960, is revoked effective concurrently with the effective date of tariff filings required by paragraph 2 hereof.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
