ORDER

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct an industrial spur track at grade across Guittard Road in the City of Burlingame, San Mateo County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. E-14.05-C. Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the road now paved, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding one percent. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs reflectorized with reflex-reflecting sheet material (General Order No. 75-B). Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

No train, engine or motor car shall be operated over said crossing unless said train, engine or motor car shall be first brought to a stop and traffic on the highway protected by a member of the train crew or other competent employee of the applicant acting as flagman.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require.

The applicant states that the industry has nearly completed construction of a warehouse building and desires that the construction of above trackage begin as soon as possible so that the track facilities will be available for service in December, 1960.
