O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct a drill track at grade across Regio Avenue in the City of Buena Park, Orange County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. BK-503.9-C.

Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72, and of a minimum width of 54 feet, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding two percent. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (General Order No. 75-B), with reflex reflecting sheet material.

Within thirty days after completion, pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

Applicant declares that the industry to be served will require service by January 15, 1961, to conform with its plans; therefore it requests waiver of the twenty-day waiting period.

The effective date of this order shall therefore be the date hereof.
