
ORDER

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to relocate a road at grade across its tracks substantially as set forth in the above numbered application, the new grade crossing to be at the location described in the application and to be identified as Crossing No. B-73.6 (Banta Road). Construction expense shall be borne in accordance with an agreement entered into between the parties relative thereto and copy of said agreement shall be filed with the Commission within 180 days from the date hereof. Should the parties fail to agree, the Commission will apportion the cost of construction by further order. County of San Joaquin shall bear maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Southern Pacific Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not less than 32 feet and grades of approach not greater than one percent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 8 flashing light signals (General Order No. 75-B) supplemented with automatic gate arms.

Upon completion, Crossing No. B-72.5, about one mile westerly, shall be abolished by physical closing by Southern Pacific Company. Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order,


applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. Applicant alleges that it needs to initiate construction in the near future, therefore the effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
