OPINION AND ORDER

Daigh & Stewart Truck Co., applicant herein, is a California corporation engaged in the transportation of property as a highway common carrier generally throughout the state. In this application it reports that certain real property located in Kern County, and now used in its operations, has been purchased by the State of California for the sum of \$73,560.50 for highway purposes, subject to approval by the Commission of the sale. The carrier has requested the Commission to make its order authorizing it to sell the property.

The Commission has considered this matter and is of the opinion, and so finds, that the proposed sale will not be adverse to the public interest and that a public hearing is not necessary, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED -

1. That Daigh & Stewart Truck Co., on or after the effective date hereof and on or before June 30, 1961, may sell the real property referred to in this proceeding to the State of California.

2. That the authorization herein granted shall not be construed to be a finding of the value of said property.

3. That this order shall become effective on the date hereof.
