O R D E R

County of Stanislaus is authorized to construct Lapham Drive at grade across tracks of Modesto and Empire Traction Company near Modesto, Stanislaus County, at the four locations set forth in the application and especially described in items #1, #2, #3 and #4 in paragraph numbered III of the application to be identified as Crossings Nos. 28-1.8-C, 28-2.07-C, 28-2.04-C and 28-2.12-C, respectively. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Modesto and Empire Traction Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of each crossing shall be not less than 24 feet and grades of approach not greater than two percent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection at each crossing shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (General Order No. 75-B).

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience,

necessity, or safety so require. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
