SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

By the Order in its Decision No. 59912, dated April 12, 1960, in the above entitled proceeding, the Commission authorized construction of a grade separation, removal of an existing grade separation as well as the alteration of two grade crossings, in conjunction with an improvement project of State Route 68 (U.S. 101) in the vicinity of Santa Clara, Santa Clara County.

Among various provisions, the Order sets forth the following statement regarding the alteration authorization made with respect to Crossing No. L-42.8 (Laurelwood Road):

"(1) The protection to be provided at Crossing No. L-42.8 (Laurelwood Road) is currently under negotiation between the City of Santa Clara and the applicant. Accordingly, the matter of protection at this crossing shall be the subject of further order of this Commission."

Being informed that the City of Santa Clara is no longer negotiating the matter of protection at Crossing No. L-42.8 (Laurelwood Road) with the applicant pursuant to the Commission's proceeding in Application No. 41573 and good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the applicant is authorized to undertake the alterations set forth in the application as amended to Crossing No. L-42.8 (Laurelwood Road) subject to provisions in Decision No. 59912 as well as the requirement that two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (General Order No. 75-B) equipped with reflex-reflective sheet material be installed as protection.

In all other respects, Decision No. 59912 is in full force and effect.
