ORDER SUSPENDING OPERATIVE RIGHTS

Trojan Furniture Express, a corporation, possesses certificates of public convenience and necessity to operate as a highway common carrier and an express corporation for the transportation of new furniture between San Francisco, Sacramento and Los Angeles. This authority was granted and acquired by Decisions Nos. 42288, 47624 and 59078. The corporate name of the applicant was changed from Pixley Transportation to Trojan Furniture Express by authority of Decision No. 59918, dated April 12, 1960, in Application No. 29810.

On January 9, 1961, the applicant filed an application requesting that this Commission issue an ex parte order authorizing the suspension of applicant's highway common carrier certificates and express corporation certificate for a period of 24 months. The application alleges that the applicant's stockholders also own and manage the Trojan Transportation and Warehouse Co., a California corporation, which has been operating profitably as a permitted carrier and that they hope to continue their permitted service and suspend the certificates of the applicant due to severe losses which have totaled \$33,924.08 for the first 11 months of 1960. The application further alleges that the applicant cannot operate profitably as a certificated carrier of new furniture under present conditions and that no public service will

be impaired if the application is granted because numerous other certificated carriers serve the entire area the applicant will relinquish.

In the circumstances, the applicant's certificates of public convenience and necessity and tariffs will be suspended for a period of 12 months. Applicant is hereby admonished that if it does not wish to operate this service after the termination of the period of suspension, its certificates will be subject to revocation.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED:

(1) That the certificates of public convenience and necessity acquired by Decisions Nos. 42288, 47624 and 59078 and transferred to the present applicant by a change of the corporate name in Decision No. 59918, dated April 12, 1960, are hereby suspended for a period of 12 months from the date of this order.

(2) That all tariffs issued by or on behalf of Trojan Furniture Express, a corporation, are hereby suspended for 12 months from the date of this order. A copy of this order shall be filed with said tariffs in the office of the Commission.

(3) That the applicant shall amend its tariffs, on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and to the public, to reflect the suspension authorized in Paragraphs 1 and 2 hereof.

The Secretary is directed to mail a copy of this order to Trojan Furniture Express.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
