SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Charles C. Canlas, doing business as Peninsula Delivery and Transport Co., was exempted from the requirements of Minimum Rate Tariff No. 2 by Decision No. 57363 dated September 23, 1958 in the transportation of drug supplies, auto parts, bakery supplies, photographic films and prints, and radio and electronic parts and equipment in shipments of 100 pounds or less between points within a 30 mile radius of the City of San Mateo.

Effective December 28, 1960 the permits held by Canlas were transferred to Joseph S. Aaronson, doing business as Peninsula Delivery and Transport Co. In proceedings in Case No. 5432, Petition No. 205, Joseph S. Aaronson testified that he had purchased the business from Charles C. Canlas. It appears that Charles C. Canlas is no longer engaged in the business of transporting property. In the circumstances, the exemption granted in Decision No. 57363 should be revoked.

Good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that Decision No. 52199, in Case No. 5432, as amended, is further amended by deleting from the list of carriers in Appendix B thereof, Charles C. Canlas, doing business as Peninsula Delivery and Transport Co.

The Secretary shall cause a certified copy of this order to be served forthwith, by registered mail, upon Charles C. Canlas at the address or addresses last shown on the Commission's records and files as the place or places that Charles C. Canlas receives mail.

The effective date of this order shall be the thirtieth day after such service unless prior to said effective date Charles C. Canlas shall have filed with this Commission a written response to this order denying the facts set forth herein, in which event the effective date of the order shall be stayed pending further order herein.
