ORDER GRANTING TEMPORARY INTERIM RELIEF

J. T. Ellis, of 4219-1/2 South Main Street, Los Angeles, California, having filed a verified complaint alleging in substance that complainant was a subscriber and user of telephone service furnished by defendant under number ADams 4-3254, that on or about November 12, 1960, the telephone facilities of complainant were disconnected by defendant pursuant to a request by the Los Angeles Police Department, purporting to be based upon probable cause for the belief that said telephone facilities were being used for unlawful purposes; that complainant has not used and does not intend to use said telephone facilities for any unlawful purpose; that complainant has suffered and will continue to suffer irreparable injury and undue hardship if deprived of said telephone facilities; and complainant having requested an order directing the defendant to reconnect and restore said telephone pending a hearing and determination of the matters raised by the complaint; and good cause appearing,
