ORDER OF DISMISSAL

By this application filed August 23, 1960, Roy J. Hauger and Samuel S. Hash seek authority to depart from the minimum rates for the transportation of forest products within a ten mile radius of Arcata and Eureka. From time to time counsel for applicants has informed the Commission that applicants were not ready to proceed, but that it was anticipated that they would be ready in the immediate future. By letter dated January 24, 1961, counsel stated that he "anticipated having matters settled within ten days or two weeks at the most". Apparently, applicants are still not prepared to go forward, therefore,
