ORDER SUSPENDING OPERATIVE EFFECT OFDECISION NO. 61510

On February 14, 1961 the Commission issued its Decision No. 61510 in the above-entitled proceeding, providing that the radial highway common carrier permit of Alvin C. Martin, doing business as A. C. Martin Trucking, should be suspended for five (5) consecutive days starting at 12:01 A.M. on the second Monday following the effective date thereof and that said order should be effective twenty (20) days after the completion of service thereof upon respondent. Service thereof was made on February 23, 1961; the effective date of said order is March 15, 1961; the suspension provided in said decision would start on March 27, 1961. A petition for rehearing has been filed on March 10, 1961.

Good cause appearing, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the operative effect of said Decision No. 61510 is hereby stayed, pending further order of the Commission herein.
