- (10) State Highway 33 between Dos Palos and Mettler Station, inclusive.
- (11) U.S. Highway 395 between the southerly limits of the Los Angeles Basin Territory and Miramar, inclusive.
- 3. Between all points specified in paragraph 2 a, b, c, d and e, above.
- 4.a. Through routes and rates may be established between any points in the areas or on the routes described in paragraph 2 above, on the one hand, and any other point in another area or on another route described in paragraph 2 above, on the other hand.
 - b. Applicants may not operate to, from or between any point within the Counties of Napa and Sonoma or within the San Francisco Territory, Los Angeles Basin Territory and San Diego Territory.
- 5. Applicants may use any and all highways and roads between the areas described, for operating convenience only.
- 6. Applicants shall not transport any shipments of:
 - a. Used household goods and personal effects not packed in accordance with the crated property requirements set forth in paragraph (d) of Item No. 10-C of Minimum Rate Tariff No. 4-A.
