ORDER DENYING REHEARING
AND
AMENDING DECISION NO. 61281

The Warehousemen's Association of the Port of San Francisco and its individual members, having filed a petition for rehearing of Decision No. 61281, and the Commission having considered said petition and each and every allegation therein, and being of the opinion that no good cause for granting a rehearing has been made to appear, and it further appearing that Private Warehouse, Inc., applicant herein, has requested that the time within which to issue the stock authorized by said decision be extended forty-five days from the date hereof,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that said petition for rehearing be and the same is hereby denied.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that ordering paragraph 3 of Decision No. 61281 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"3. That on or before the forty-fifth day after the effective date hereof Private Warehouse, Inc., may

issue not to exceed \$18,000 par value of its
capital stock for the purpose heretofore specified."
