O R D E R

State of California, Department of Public Works, is authorized to construct Puente Avenue (State Route 170) at grade across Southern Pacific Company's El Paso Route near the City of Industry, Los Angeles County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. B-498.1. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Southern Pacific Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not less than 60 feet and grades of approach not greater than three percent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 8 flashing light signals supplemented with automatic crossing gates.

Concurrently with the opening of Crossing No. B-498.1 to public use, Crossing No. B-498.2 located about 200 feet southeasterly shall be abandoned and closed by applicant. Within thirty days after

completion, pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
