SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Butane Transport Co., a corporation, operates as a petroleum irregular route carrier between all points and places in the State of California. On January 17, 1961, it filed its amended articles of incorporation changing its corporate name to Petrolane Transport. Accordingly, its certificates will be amended to show the new corporate name. It will also be ordered to amend its tariffs by filing an appropriate adoption notice. A public hearing is not necessary.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED:

(1) That Decision No. 44361, dated June 20, 1950, in Application No. 31123, is hereby amended by substituting "Petrolane Transport" in place and stead of "Butane Transport Co."

(2) That within one hundred twenty days after the effective date hereof, and on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and to the public, applicant shall supplement or reissue the tariffs on file with the Commission naming rates, rules and regulations governing the common carrier operations here involved to show that Butane Transport Co. has withdrawn or canceled and Petrolane Transport has adopted or established as its own, said

rates, rules and regulations. The tariff filings made pursuant to this order shall comply in all respects with the regulations governing the construction and filing of tariffs set forth in the Commission's General Order No. 80.

This order shall become effective twenty days after the date hereof.
