OPINION

The Greyhound Corporation requests authority to establish an additional urban route UR-13.29 from the junction of Eighth and Bryant Streets in San Francisco, thence over the newly constructed "Skyway" to the San Francisco-Oakland Bay Bridge.

It is alleged that the "Skyway" is officially designated as U. S. Highways 40 and 50 and Interstate Highway 80; that its use will result in a reduction in elapsed travel time and will increase safety of operations for its eastbound schedules operating at its Seventh and Mission Streets terminal.

After consideration the Commission finds and concludes that public convenience and necessity require the granting of the authority sought. A public hearing is not necessary.

ORDER

Application having been filed and the Commission being informed in the premises,

II IS ORDERED that:

l. A certificate of public convenience and necessity is hereby granted to The Greyhound Corporation, authorizing the establishment and operation of service as a passenger stage corporation, as that term is defined in Section 226 of the Public Utilities Code,

for the transportation of passengers, baggage and express between the points and over the routes set forth in Fourth Revised Page 83, attached hereto, as an extension and enlargement of, consolidation with and subject to all the limitations and restrictions set forth in the certificate granted by Decision No. 55893 and in particular subject to the provisions set forth in Section 3 of Appendix A thereof.

- 2. Appendix A of Decision No. 55893 is hereby amended by incorporating Fourth Revised Page 83, attached hereto, in revision of Third Revised Page 83.
- 3. In providing service pursuant to the certificate herein granted, applicant shall comply with and observe the following service regulations:
 - a. Within thirty days after the effective date hereof, applicant shall file a written acceptance of the certificate herein granted.
 - b. Within one hundred twenty days after the effective date hereof, and not less than five days' notice to the Commission and to the public, applicant shall establish the service herein authorized and file in triplicate, and concurrently make effective, tariffs and timetables satisfactory to the Commission.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.

- UR-13.27 From junction Potrero Avenue and Army Street, over Army Street to junction Third Street.
- UR-13.28 From junction Folsom Street and Second Street, over Second Street to Harrison Street.
- *UR-13.29 From junction Eighth and Bryant Streets and the access highway to the Skyway, over the Skyway to the San Francisco-Oakland Bay Bridge.
