BEFORE THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

In the Matter of the Application of SOUTHERN PACIFIC COMPANY for authority to abandon its Class "A" non-agency station at Oakland, Jack London Square, in the County of Alameda, State of California, to cancel all tariffs to and from said station, to delete said station from the timetables, and to correct records accordingly.

ORDER

The verified application of Southern Pacific Company filed on February 17, 1961, discloses that no freight business has been transacted at applicant's station at Oakland, Jack London Square, Alameda County, during the past year and that continued maintenance thereof is not necessary.

It being found that public convenience and necessity no longer require the maintenance of such service, Southern Pacific Company is authorized to abandon its non-agency station at Oakland, Jack London Square, County of Alameda; to eliminate said name from its station records; and to cancel all tariffs and time schedules applying at said station on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and the public. Such tariff changes shall quote this decision number as the requisite authority. This order shall not be construed as authorization to increase rates or charges.

Within thirty days after abandonment as authorized herein, applicant shall so notify the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year, unless

time be extended. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
