ORDER VACATING SUSPENSION OF OPERATIVE RIGHTS

Decision No. 61491, dated February 14, 1961, in this proceeding, provided for the suspension of the certificate of public convenience and necessity of Los Angeles Transport & Warehouse Cogranted by Decision No. 55357, dated August 5, 1957, in this proceeding, unless prior to the effective date of Decision No. 61491 it shall have filed with this Commission a proper and lawful freight classification as required by Sections 485 and 493 of the Public Utilities Code, in which event the order would be stayed.

On March 6, 1961, the Western Classification Committee, Agent, filed Supplement No. 22 to its Western Classification 77 reinstating Los Angeles Transport & Warehouse Co. as a participant in said classification, effective April 17, 1961. Inasmuch as the required classification is now on file, Decision No. 61491, supra, will be vacated concurrently with the date participation in said classification by Los Angeles Transport & Warehouse Co. becomes effective.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that Decision No. 61491, dated February 14, 1961, in Application No. 35918, is hereby vacated and set aside.

The Secretary of the Commission is directed to cause service of a certified copy of this order to be made upon Los Angeles Transport & Warehouse Co.

The effective date of this order shall be April 17, 1961.
