ORDER DISMISSING PETITION OF MARCH 31, 1961

Decision No. 60612, issued August 23, 1960, after public hearing, dismissed the above complaint. Complainant petitioned for rehearing on September 12, 1960. Rehearing was denied on October 14, 1960. (Decision No. 60883.)

On March 31, 1961, over five months after denial of rehearing, complainant filed a document entitled "Petition to rescind D 60612, leave to clarify petition, and for Commission Investigation." This document asserts in effect that the complaint in Case No. 6333 (referred to as "petition" by complainant) was misconstrued and misinterpreted.

Decision No. 60612 has long since become final. No good cause has been shown for the reopening of Case No. 6333.

The petition filed on March 31, 1961 is hereby dismissed.
