SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

By the terms of the Commission's Order in its Decision No. 59568, dated February 1, 1960, in the above-entitled proceeding, applicant, City of Fremont, is authorized to construct Maple Street at grade across tracks of Southern Pacific Company (Crossing No. DAB-40.0) in Fremont, Alameda County, subject to various provisions therein, including a requirement that two Standard No. 8 flashing light signals (G.O. 75B) shall be installed as protection.

By a letter dated February 28, 1961, applicant requests Commission approval of two non-standard traffic signal type signal devices to supplement the aforementioned Standard No. 8 signals and Southern Pacific Company has indicated its concurrence to the installation.

Since these proposed non-standard signal devices to provide control of vehicular traffic at the intersection of Maple Street and Baine Avenue (City of Fremont) are desirable with regard to the protection needs at the proposed grade crossing of Maple Street (Crossing No. DAB-40.0) adjacent to this intersection and good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the following last sentence of the first paragraph on Page 1 of Decision No. 59568, reading as follows:

"Protection shall be by two Standard No. 8 flashing light signals (General Order No. 75-B)"

is modified to read:

"Protection shall be by:

(a) Two Standard No. 8 flashing light signals (General

Order No. 75-B).

- (b) One signal to be installed in the northeast quadrant of Crossing No. DAB -40.0 facing eastbound Baine Avenue traffic, said signal to be of the red neon lighting type with a message reading "NO RIGHT TURN" which shall be shown by actuation from train movements at or on the approach to the crossing.
- (c) One signal to be installed in the northeast quadrant of Crossing No. DAB-40.0 facing westbound Baine Avenue traffic, said signal to be of the red neon lighting type with a message reading "NO LEFT TURN" which shall be shown by actuation from train movements at or on the approach to the crossing."

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the time limit within which applicant may exercise the authority granted in said decision be and it is hereby extended to August 1, 1961.

In all other respects Decision No. 59568 is reaffirmed and is in full force and effect.
