O P I N I O N

By this application, filed herein on February 8, 1961, Tanner Motor Tours, Ltd., proposes and requests authority to establish a new passenger stage route in addition to its present passenger stage service in the Palm Springs area.

As justification for the proposal it is alleged that the City Council of the City of Palm Springs in a resolution, No. 6053, dated November 23, 1960, strongly urges and requests the applicant to provide the additional service. The proposed service is not competitive with any other carrier. It is alleged that copies of this application have been sent to local authorities and interested parties. No protests have been received. No abandonment of a present route or reduction of service thereon is proposed in connection with this application.

The additional service will be on the same seasonal basis as the present service, that is, between September and June, with no service on Sundays.

Initially, two round trips daily are proposed, leaving the intersection of Palm Canyon Drive and Tachevah Drive, at 8 a.m. and 5 p.m., thence through the eastern part of Palm Springs and return. A one-way adult fare of 20 cents will apply with children under five years of age being carried free. A transfer between the proposed service and the existing service will be provided for a 5-cent additional charge.

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The Commission having considered the matter, finds that public convenience and necessity require that applicant be granted authority to establish a new passenger stage service as hereinafter set forth. The application will be granted. A public hearing is not deemed necessary.

O R D E R

An application having been filed, the Commission having found that public convenience and necessity require that applicant establish service as authorized herein, and based on said finding,

IT IS ORDERED:

1. That a certificate of public convenience and necessity be and it hereby is granted to Tanner Motor Tours, Ltd., authorizing it to establish and operate a service for the transportation of persons as a passenger stage corporation, as defined in Section 226 of the Public Utilities Code, between the points and over the route more particularly set forth in First Revised Page 16 of Appendix A of Decision No. 61751, attached hereto and made a part hereof.

2. That Appendix A of Decision No. 61751 in Application No. 42447 is hereby amended by incorporating First Revised Page 16 in revision of Original Page 16.

3. That in providing service pursuant to the certificate herein granted, Tanner Motor Tours, Ltd., shall comply with the following service regulations:

- a. Within thirty days after the effective date hereof, applicant shall file a written acceptance of the certificate herein granted. By accepting the certificate of public convenience and necessity herein granted, applicant is placed on notice that it will be required, among other things, to file annual reports of its operations and to comply with and observe the safety rules and other regulations of

the Commission's General Order No. 98 and insurance requirements of the Commission's General Order No. 101-A. Failure to file such reports, in such form and at such time as the Commission may direct, or to comply with and observe the provisions of General Orders Nos. 98 and 101-A, may result in a cancellation of the operating authority granted by this decision.

- b. Within one hundred twenty days after the effective date hereof, and on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and the public, applicant shall establish the service herein authorized and file in triplicate and concurrently make effective, tariffs and timetables satisfactory to the Commission.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.

Tanner Motor Tours, Ltd., is authorized to provide passenger stage service for the transportation of persons in the City of Palm Springs and vicinity between the points and along the routes as follows:

330 Commencing at the intersection of Palm Canyon Drive and Yorba Road, thence southerly along Palm Canyon Drive to the Casetas del Monte Hotel; northerly along Palm Canyon Drive to State Highway 111; easterly along State Highway 111 to the Smoketree Ranch; westerly along State Highway 111 to Palm Canyon Drive; northerly along Palm Canyon Drive to Olivera Street; easterly along Olivera Street to Indian Avenue; northerly along Indian Avenue to San Carlos Street; westerly along San Carlos Street to Virginia Street; northerly along Virginia Street to Yorba Road; westerly along Yorba Road to the point of beginning.

* Commencing at the intersection of Palm Canyon Drive and Tachevah Drive, thence along Tachevah Drive, Indian Avenue, Tahquitz Drive, McCallum Way, El Cielo Road, Sunny Dunes Road, Williams Road, Ramon Road, Indian Avenue and Tachevah Drive to point of beginning.

335 Tanner Motor Tours, Ltd., is authorized to provide passenger stage service for the transportation of persons and their baggage from the Palm Springs Territory, as designated in Item No. 155, to the Southern Pacific Railway Company's Palm Springs passenger station at White-water, and from the said passenger station to the Palm Springs Territory along the most appropriate and direct routes.
