OPINION AND ORDER

By petition filed March 14, 1961, Proctor and Gamble Distributing Company requests revision of Minimum Rate Tariff No. 2 so as to include "Peanut Spread" in the list of articles in Item No. 320 of said tariff taking exception ratings applicable to "canned goods."

Petitioner has a product marketed nationally under the brand name of "Jif" which is a blend of approximately 75 percent roasted peanuts. It has the general appearance and usage of peanut butter. Petitioner alleges that its value, transportation characteristics and methods of packing and shipping are the same as peanut butter. It is called peanut spread because the U. S. Food and Drug Administration has ruled that a product which is labeled, advertised, marketed and otherwise held out as peanut butter must consist of not less than 87 percent ground peanuts.

Peanut spread is rated as a sandwich spread. Both peanut butter and sandwich spread are listed in Item No. 320 under "canned goods." For marketing reasons petitioner would prefer to ship its product as peanut spread rather than sandwich spread.

The proposal does not involve an increase or decrease in rating but merely a change of description. We take notice that the
