Application of the County of Santa Clara,
 State of California, for an order
 authorizing construction of a crossing at
 separated grades over the tracks of the
 Southern Pacific Company in connection
 with improvement of Curtner Avenue in
 Santa Clara County, sometimes referred to
 as "Curtner Avenue Overhead".

O R D E R

County of Santa Clara is authorized to construct
 Curtner Avenue at separated grades over the track of Southern Pacific
 Company near San Jose, Santa Clara County, at the location and
 substantially as set forth in the application, to be identified as
 Crossing No. E-50.0-A. Construction and maintenance expense shall be
 borne in accordance with an agreement to be entered into between the
 parties relative thereto, and copy of said agreement, together with
 plans of said crossing approved by Southern Pacific Company, shall
 be filed with the Commission within 180 days from the date hereof.
 Should the parties fail to agree, the Commission will apportion the
 cost of construction and maintenance by further order.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order
 applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This
 authorization shall expire if not exercised within three years unless
 time be extended or if conditions are not complied with.

Applicant alleges that it would be beneficial for
 construction work to commence as early as possible in the coming

construction season and asks that the authorization requested be made effective immediately. Therefore, the effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
