FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Decision No. 61583, in ordering paragraph No. 4 requires Harold J. Hicks, doing business as Palm Valley Water Company, to file a certain map to be drawn to an indicated scale not smaller than 400 feet to the inch.

The utility alleges that if the said map were to be drawn to the scale required, it would be of such size as to be most unwieldy and would not serve the Commission's requirements as well as a map drawn to a scale of 1,000 feet to the inch. Accordingly, request is made for authority to file maps drawn to the latter scale.


It appearing to the Commission that the order should be modified as requested by the applicant; therefore,

Decision No. 61583 is modified by substituting "1,000 feet to the inch" for the map scale of "400 feet to the inch" in ordering paragraph No. 4.


Except as modified by this order, said Decision No. 61583 shall, in all respects, be and continue in full force and effect.
