BEFORE THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

Application of the State of California, Department of Public Works, for an order authorizing the widening of an existing crossing at separated grades whereby State Route IX-Ker-58-E will be carried over the tracks of the Southern Pacific Company in Kern County, sometimes referred to as "Tehachapi Creek Bridge & Overhead".

ORDER

State of California, Department of Public Works, is authorized to widen State Route 58 (U. S. 466) at separated grades over the tracks of Southern Pacific Company, near Woodford, Kern County, at the location and substantially as shown in the application to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. B-348.3-A. Construction and maintenance expense shall be borne in accordance with an agreement to be entered into between the parties relative thereto, and copy of said agreement, together with plans of said crossing approved by Southern Pacific Company, shall be filed with the Commission within 180 days from the date hereof. Should the parties fail to agree, the Commission will apportion the cost of construction and maintenance by further order.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within two years unless time be extended or if conditions are not complied with. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
