ORDER SUSPENDING OPERATIVE RIGHTS

The certificate of insurance of Mack Nishimoto, dba Nishimoto Bros., lapsed as of March 1, 1961. Evidence of liability protection required by General Order No. 100A not being on file, and the Commission being of the opinion and finding that such failure constitutes good cause for suspension of certificates and of tariffs applicable to services thereunder,

IT IS ORDERED:

(1) That the certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a highway common carrier granted to Mack Nishimoto by Decision No. 53939, dated October 16, 1956, in Application No. 36196, is hereby suspended pending further order.


(2) That all tariffs issued by or on behalf of Mack Nishimoto, doing business as Nishimoto Bros., are hereby suspended pending further order. A copy of this order shall be filed with said tariffs in the office of the Commission.

The Secretary is directed to cause service of a certified copy of this order to be made upon Mack Nishimoto.






