ORDER SUSPENDING OPERATIVE RIGHTS

The certificate of insurance of J. D. Roach and Tom Roach, doing business as Roach Transportation Company, lapsed as of March 31, 1961.¹ In addition, applicants' tariff has not been amended as required by certain outstanding minimum rate orders of the Commission issued in 1959 and 1960.

The carrier having failed to maintain its tariff on file in conformity with the Commission's outstanding minimum rate orders and having failed to maintain on file evidence of liability protection required by General Order No. 100A and the Commission being of the opinion and finding that such failures constitute good cause for suspension of certificates and of tariffs applicable to services thereunder,

IT IS ORDERED:

(1) That the certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a highway common carrier acquired by J. D. Roach and Tom Roach by Decision No. 60206, dated May 31, 1960, in Application No. 42158, is hereby suspended pending further order.


This carrier holds a certificate authorizing service as a highway common carrier for the transportation of certain specified commodities between San Diego and vicinity, on the one hand, and the Los Angeles Territory, on the other hand.


(2) That all tariffs issued by or on behalf of J. D. Roach and Tom Roach, doing business as Roach Transportation Company, are hereby suspended pending further order. A copy of this order shall be filed with said tariffs in the office of the Commission.


The Secretary is directed to cause service of a certified copy of this order to be made upon J. D. Roach and Tom Roach.


The effective date of this order shall be the fifth day after such service, unless before such effective date J. D. Roach and Tom Roach shall have filed with this Commission evidence of insurance protection as required by General Order No. 100A, and shall have filed a written response to this order denying the facts set forth herein and requesting public hearing, in which event the effective date of this order shall be stayed until further order of the Commission.
