ORDER EXTENDING INTERIM AUTHORITY

In prior proceedings in Application No. 40057 and in Application No. 40336 Greyhound and the Commission's staff were directed to develop certain data necessary for the determination of a permanent fare structure. By Decision No. 61170 dated December 13, 1960 herein, because of certain increases in the cost of performing operations incurred on and after March 1, 1960, the Commission authorized Greyhound and Transcontinental, et al, to establish certain interim increases in passenger fares. It appearing at the time that Greyhound and the staff would have completed by March, 1961 the assembling and analysis of data for the establishment of a permanent fare structure, the authority granted Greyhound to maintain interim fares was scheduled to expire June 30, 1961.

We have been informed that Greyhound and the staff have completed their studies and are ready to proceed. Public hearing has been scheduled for June 6, 1961 at San Francisco. It is probable that a permanent fare structure which would be prescribed by the Commission could not be published and made effective on or before June 30, 1961. In the circumstances, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that the authority granted in Decision No. 61170 to The Greyhound Corporation, Western Greyhound Lines Division, to establish interim passenger fares is extended until further order of the Commission.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
